During the visit, Ambassador Shahabuddin held meeting with the Acting President, Vice-Presidents, Dean of Admissions and his team, senior faculty members and student representatives. It was a useful meeting

where the present situation and future potential areas of cooperation with RAPU to the benefit of students could be identified. RAPU is one of the top universities in Japan that has been welcoming students from Bangladesh since its establishment in 2000. So far around 450 Bangladeshi students graduated from the university.

The RAPU alumni network is helping the current students to get job (97% job success). This year (2023), 128 students students applied in undergraduate and postgraduate courses so far. The university has three colleges, namely College of International Management (APM), College of Asia Pacific Studies (APS) and the relatively new College

of Sustainability and Tourism (ST). This new college on Sustainability and Tourism has more potential for Bangladesh as the country is looking for investment promotion in Tourism sector and at the same time sustainable management of Environment and climate impact in Bangladesh. Later the Ambassador also visited different parts of the university including library and student dorm facilities. Ambassador Shahabuddin made a keynote speech at the lecture hall of the university on "How does Leadership matter? Looking at Bangladesh-Japan friendly relations". He answered to question asked by faculty later on. In the evening the Ambassador and DCM attended the grand show culminating the colourful

"Bangladesh Week" organized by students at the Millennium Hall of RAPU from 19-23 June 2023. The Ambassador made a brief remark and opened the show. Colourful performance, drama, dance etc. marked the event organized first time after pandemic enthralling the audience. The presence of H.E. Ambassador encouraged all students.
